

GROUNDS COMMITTEE John Mientus, chair 860-749-0381

Supervise and maintain club grounds, arrange for grass cutting, tree pruning, clearing of underbrush and general improvement of club property. Maintain picnic area and general policing of club grounds (excluding pool and boatyard areas). Duties include: gutter cleaning, branch/limb collection, rubbish barrel emptying and cleaning, and spring mulching. *Members should have riding lawn mower experience.*

POOL COMMITTEE Bud Breeding, Chair 567-7957

In addition to assisting in opening and closing the pools each season, committee members routinely maintain the pool deck, the pool area lawn and fence, locker rooms, pool area furniture, and filtering equipment. Experience with concrete, plaster, tile work, and/or a general mechanical aptitude would be helpful. Although there are a few ongoing maintenance projects throughout the summer season, the bulk of this committee's work is done in the spring to prepare and open the pools for the season. **Availability and willingness to work during the pool opening process (late April-May) is important.**

HOUSE COMMITTEE Ann-Marie Kristoffy, Chair 567-8389

Oversee care, maintenance, general repair and use of PVYC Clubhouse.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE Linda Abrams, Chair 567-1710

Process billing, waiting list and application requests. Duties involve making calls, collating mailings, welcoming new members. Duties also include Annual Meeting reception and ballot control. **Committee usually has no openings as it requires only 1-2 members.**
