

Covid-19 Pool Restrictions

- All members over the age of 2 years **must** wear masks when entering the pool area and when the 6 foot social distancing is not possible, e.g. in the restrooms or walking around the pool deck. Masks are not to be worn when in the water.
- The lifeguard will be wearing a mask at all times except when in the water or the pump room.
- All members and guests will be checking in with the lifeguard when entering the pool gate.
- Once you enter the gate, follow the arrow on the deck so that you are moving in a one-way clockwise direction to allow for social distancing and travel across the grass if you are going to a lawn chair.
- Maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from anyone not in your family group. The lounge chairs have been placed at a distance of 6 feet from each other centered on a line of tape on the deck. If you move a chair any closer than 6 feet in order to accommodate members of your immediate family, please **return the chair to its original location** when you leave.
- The Longmeadow Board of Health has permitted us to have no more than 32 people in the pool area at the same time. In past years, it was unusual for us to exceed that number of people in the pool area but, with the pent-up demand and on particularly hot days, it is certainly possible that we will reach our maximum capacity. All members should call 413-567-0258 and speak with the lifeguard to determine if there is space at the pool to avoid the chance of getting turned away. If overcrowding becomes an issue then we may need to require reservations for limited periods of time throughout the day.
- Requirements have been relaxed under Phase 3 and you may now change clothes in the pool restroom area.
- No water toys, squirt guns, balls, floats, games, or any other items that have the potential for communal use may be brought into the pool area. Children are allowed to wear swimwear but they are not to be shared.

We ask that all members help us to keep the pool area safe for everyone by doing the following:

- Do not come to the pool if you have a fever or chills, a dry cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, or any of the [other possible symptoms of Covid-19](#)
- Wash your hands frequently or use the sanitizer that is located at the lifeguard table and in the restrooms
- When you have finished using the restroom facilities, wipe down the sink and toilet handles with the disinfecting wipes that are located in each bathroom
- When you are leaving, use one of the sanitizing wipes located at the lifeguard table or in the restrooms to clean off the arms of your lounge chair for the next person
